1. Self nomination is not accepted.
2. Nomination form should be completed with block letters.
3. Detailed description of reasons for nomination, bibliography, information about the developers and companies having applied the innovation to mass production, other related documents may be enclosed to the nomination form.
4. When nominating a group of scientists it is compulsory to state the contribution of each group member.
5. Only the nomination forms of the current year are eligible for the nomination. The forms are not saved in the database and are not submitted for the following year.
6. Nomination for the Prize cannot be posthumous or repeated.
7. The Prize is not awarded to the members of Prize Committee, International Advisory Board, Expert Group and Noble Prize Laureates in Physics, Chemistry and Medicine.
8. Prize Committee and Expert Group members do not possess the right to nominate for the Prize.
9. The nominations are strictly confidential. Information about presented innovations, authors and companies having applied the innovation to mass production is confidential.
10. Completed nomination form should be received via mail or fax by May 25, 2009, (based on the date of the incoming post stamp).
11. Nomination forms contravening the order or terms of submission are not accepted for consideration.

About Nanotechnology International Prize «RUSNANOPRIZE»

- Nanotechnology International Prize «RUSNANOPRIZE» (the Prize) is established according to the decision of Supervisory Council of Russian Corporation of Nanotechnologies (RUSNANO) dated December 1, 2008.
- The Prize will be awarded on a yearly basis for scientific-technological research and innovations and their application to mass production. In 2009 the Prize monetary fund will exceed 80 000USD.
- RUSNANO finances the Prize using its own and attracted funds.
- Researchers, scientists and developers (up to three people) being the authors of scientific-technological innovation or innovations on one topic or one field that have been applied to production will be awarded by monetary part of the Prize, Prize Symbol, Prize Honorary Diploma and laureate pin.
- The company being the first to apply the innovation (innovations) to mass production or having reached maximum business success through the application of the innovation (innovations) will be awarded by the Prize Honorary Diploma and Prize Symbol.
- The Prize Administrative Bodies are Prize Committee, International Advisory Board, Department of Nanotechnologies and Information Technologies of Russian Academy of Sciences, Expert Group and Prize Directorate.
- RUSNANO Executive Board forms and approves Prize Committee and International Advisory Board. Term of powers of Prize Committee and International Advisory Board members is 3 years.
- Prize Committee consists of 11 members, who are mainly Russian citizens. They are 5 representatives of innovative business, including 1 Co-Chairman; 5 scientists including 1 Co-Chairman, and 1 Prize Committee Secretary. On a yearly basis Prize Committee makes the decision regarding the Prize awarding according to one of the following fields: NanoElectronics, NanoMaterials, NanoBiotechnology and NanoDiagnostics. Prize Committee Co-Chairmen are RUSNANO CEO Anatoly Chubais and Vice-president of Russian Academy of Sciences, Nobel Prize Laureate Zhores Alferov.
- International Advisory Board consists of representatives of international business and leading international scientists (5 businessmen and 5 scientists).
- Prize Committee approves Expert Group for each of four fields (NanoElectronics, NanoMaterials, NanoBiotechnologies and Nanodiagnosics), according to which the Prize Laureates are selected. Each Expert Group consists of up to 10 persons, whose term of powers equals 1 year. Expert Group carries out the expertise of presented applications independently or with the assistance of international experts.
- The right to nominate for the Prize belongs to the Nobel Prize laureates in physics, chemistry and medicine, who are not the members of the Prize Committee; members of Department of Nanotechnologies and Information Technologies of Russian Academy of Sciences, Nanotechnology International Prize "RUSNANOPRIZE" laureates (starting from 2010), members of International Advisory Board, members of RUSNANO Supervisory Council, Scientific and Technological Council, and persons recommended by the Prize Committee members from amongst heads of Chairs, professors of leading universities, researchers of scientific centers and businessmen. The indicated list is approved by Co-Chairmen of the Prize Committee.
- Expert Group carries out the expertise of received applications. Five best applications will be handled to Department of Nanotechnologies and Information Technologies of Russian Academy of Sciences and International Advisory Board for rating voting. As the result of the rating voting each of the abovementioned bodies selects 2 (two) best applications. The following persons, whose projects are nominated for the Prize during the current Prize circle, are not allowed to take part in voting: members of Department of Nanotechnologies and Information Technologies of Russian Academy of Sciences, International Advisory Board, Prize Committee and Expert Group.
- The Prize Laureates are determined by the Prize Committee out of applications selected during the voting of Department of Nanotechnologies and Information Technologies of Russian Academy of Sciences and International Advisory Board.
- Awarding ceremony will be held during the Second Nanotechnology International Forum in Moscow, October 6-8, 2009.
- RUSNANO fulfils the functions of Prize Directorate and provides organizational and administrative support of the Prize.
